Grad List Postings

Students on track will have their ASN posted to the list at the end of November, March and the start of May.

Parents will be notified if student is removed from the grad list.

Students must be on track for credit completion and have passing marks in all courses needed to earn their diploma (English and Social for sure).

Students taking courses through Next Step or ADLC need to be 75% complete their courses by May 1.



Graduation Fees

All school fees must be paid in order to purchase tickets to the graduation ceremony and prom. A Grad Fee of \$75 is charged to each graduate and this is already on your School Fees. The Grad Fee includes:

- Grad Gown Rental
- Grad Cap and Tassel (keep)
- Diploma Cover
- Lanyard
- Grad Video (code for online download)
- Graduate's attendance at ceremony

Commencement Rehearsal:

June 7th 3:45 p.m. to 5:00 p.m.

At Salisbury Composite High School

- **Mandatory for all students**
- **No parents at rehearsal**

- Students are asked to **arrive at 3:45 p.m.** We will start on time.
- Rehearsal should be completed by 5:00 p.m.
- Grad Gown Pick-up – immediately after rehearsal (Room TBD)



Grad Gown

- Grad Gown Pick-up – immediately after rehearsal.
- Students are to return the Grad Gown **within 30 minutes of the ceremony** in Room 302 inside Expo Centre.
- This means that photos should be taken prior to the ceremony. Gowns are shipped directly to warehouse - they do not come back to the school.
- Students are to keep the cap and tassel.
- **Students who have not returned their gown or who have returned a gown that is damaged will be charged for the cost of the gown.**



Commencement at Expo Centre

June 8th, 2019 1:00 p.m. (doors open at 12:00pm general seating)

At Northlands Expo Centre (Hall D)



- Students must arrive no later than **12:00 p.m. (with Gown & Cap)**. **This is particularly important as this will be their first time at the EXPO Centre.**
- Ceremony begins at 1:00 p.m. and concludes at approximately 3:30 p.m.
- Parking will be **extremely busy** and may take longer than expected. Please plan to arrive early. Cost for parking will be \$9.00 for the day. Please mention that you are there for the Salisbury Composite Grad.
- All guests will require a ticket in order to enter Hall D for the Ceremony.

Tickets will only be sold to students who do not have any outstanding fees.

Tickets will be issued to students in the general office - no replacement tickets will be given. Payment can be made by cash, cheque, credit or debit.

Ceremony Tickets are \$20 each (no ticket needed for graduate).
