SALISBURY IN HOUSE - AWARDS CRITERIA 2024

Deadline to apply is April 12

Dean Bencharsky Memorial Scholarship: Eligible recipients must be in their graduating year at Salisbury Composite High School and are enrolled in pursuing a trades apprenticeship post-graduation (with preference given to students in the Autobody Technician field). The Dean Bencharsky Apprenticeship Award is presented by Fix Auto Sherwood Park. The recipient will be chosen based off grades, dedication to their respective trade, and a desire to become an apprentice post-graduation. (\$1000.00)

Edmonton Oil Kings Academic & Athletic Scholarship: Student enrolled in Sabre or community athletics 2/3 years, has a 70% average. Student must be a good citizen, has a history of volunteerism, and have conditional acceptance to post-secondary. (\$1000.00)

Hartwell Family Award: Awarded to a student who has satisfactorily completed their 30 level credits and is pursuing a trade in an apprenticeship program. (\$1000.00)

ICON by Lifetouch: Awarded to a grade 12 student entering a visual art or performing arts program in post-secondary. (\$1000.00 per year)

John Gavinchuk Memorial Scholarship: Awarded to a qualifying grade 12 student entering a post-secondary institution in the studies of education (University of Alberta). (\$1500.00)

Kevin Gaetz Award: Recognizing and supporting students in their pursuit of post-secondary education. Must meet entrance requirements for their chosen program of studies and have a financial need that would restrict their ability to pursue post-secondary studies. Student must demonstrate perseverance, commitment, desire and determination to pursue further learning. (\$500.00)

Konica Minolta Award: Awarded to 3 EIPS students that have overcome adversity to graduate. Student must demonstrate a strong work ethic, optimism, resilience, knowledge and success. (\$500.00)

Merit Contractor's Award: Be enrolled in grade 12 and display high interest in CTS construction courses. Students demonstrates leadership in the classroom and exhibits a co-operative approach with fellow students and teachers. (\$300.00)

Nicholas Keroack Memorial Fund Scholarship: Awarded to a student entering a trade and is involved in Sabre Athletics (preferably football). (\$1000.00)

Rotary Club (Sherwood Park): Awarded annually to a student who has demonstrated significant academic improvement during their high school career, and who has made contributions to their school and/or community consistent with Rotary motto of 'service before self". Scholarship to be presented at a Rotary Club meeting, with certificate and plaque awarded at the school awards ceremony. (\$1000.00 & plaque)

Sherwood Park Elks: Awarded to an EIPS grad whose shown commitment to volunteerism and involvement in school and community. Must have post-secondary conditional acceptance. Students with financial need will be given consideration. (\$400.00)



EDMONTON OIL KINGS ACADEMIC AND ATHLETIC SCHOLARSHIP (\$1000.00)

Scholarship Criteria:

- Have been enrolled in Sabre Athletics or Community Athletic Programs for at least two of their three years at Salisbury Composite High School.
- Have maintained an academic average in their core subjects of at least 70%.
- Have been good citizens in the school and community, showing respect to coaches, teachers, officials and all staff where the student attends.
- Has shown history of volunteerism in the school/community.
- Financial need may be a factor for the recipient.
- Proof of conditional acceptance to or enrollment to a secondary institution in Canada.
- Two letters of reference are required, from a coach or a teacher. (essay word processed in size 12 font, Times New Roman).
- An essay of approximately 250 words stating the applicants plans for post-secondary education and their future goals.
- A completed resume and the application in its entirety (high light career objectives, work experience, education history, interests, accomplishments and references).
