




VALEDICTORIAN


- Valedictorian by definition, is the student with the highest academic average in their senior year who delivers the valedictory speech the graduation.
- Following the example of the Alexander Rutherford Criteria, at SAL, we use all grade 12 (or 30 level) course marks in our calculation. ELA must be used along with the top four marks from all other subjects to calculate an average for each student based on the five marks. The student with the highest average is named the valedictorian.
- The valedictorian is usually decided upon in Mid-May.

A recent photo from high school — formal or fun — that shows who they are today.








Commencement – the venue










COMMENCEMENT
